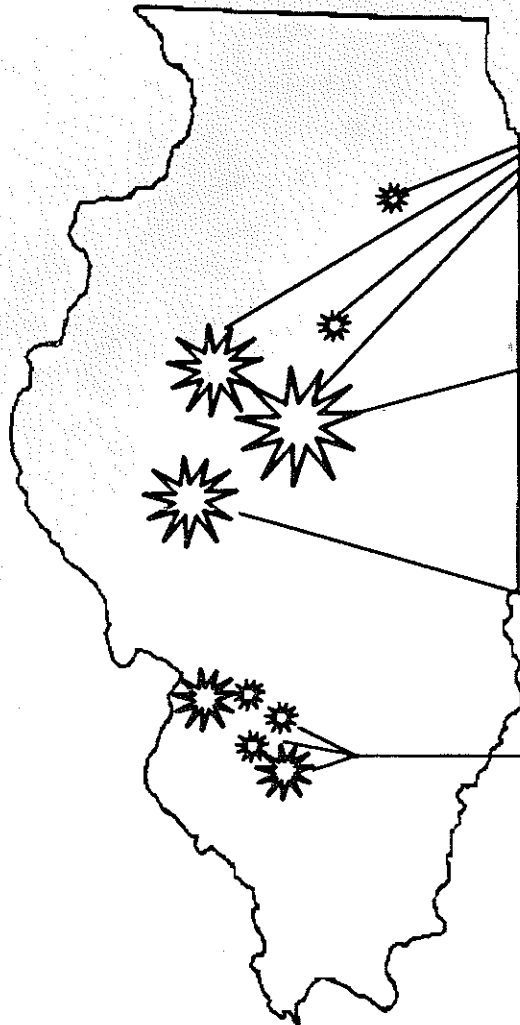


Fight the Union Busters *Solidarity March & Rally*

North & Central Ill. — 14,000 Caterpillar workers in Peoria, Decatur, Pontiac, and Aurora have been working without a contract for over a year.

Decatur — 800 employees of A. E. Staley Mfg. Co. have been under attack by Staley, Tate & Lyle, and ADM.

Springfield — Central Illinois Public Service Company locked out 1,700 utility workers.

Southern Illinois — The United Mine Workers are striking multiple coal companies.
